REPORT REGARDING WATER WELL NO. 1 AND NEEDED REPAIRS

Sean Humble discussed the history of Water Well No. 1, including past repairs and issues. After discussion, Director Shepard moved approval of Phase II of the report from C&C Water Services which includes swaging and repairing the break to allow the well to be televised. The motion was seconded by Director Ross and carried by unanimous vote.

With the well inoperable, the Board also discussed the project to bring surface water to Water Plant No. 1. Sean Humble presented a topographic survey proposal from McKim and Creed in the amount of \$13,895.00. Director Shepard moved approval of the proposal as recommended by the District's engineer, which motion was seconded by Director Blackwell and carried by unanimous vote.
